Rules & Regulations

These rules are given as guidelines for every student to follow. This code of conduct has been established for your protection and the benefit of every person present. **Rules must be obeyed at all times!** By attending, you have pledged yourself to abide by this code during the time you are at Retreat.

1. Each Student must agree to abide by the dress code at all times. See Retreat Dress Code.

2. The daily schedule must be observed by all. Attendance at all retreat activities is required of all students unless granted permission by the Retreat Staff.

3. No one is allowed to leave the campground without specific permission from the Retreat Director.

4. Possession or use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol is forbidden and will result in dismissal.

5. **Ipohones, cell phones, ipods, mp3 players, radios handheld video games, communication devices, firearms, knives or articles of clothing displaying questionable content are NOT allowed.**

6. No fireworks, water guns, water balloons used for unauthorized activities will be allowed.

7. We reserve the right to inspect contents of all personal belongings. The holding and/or

disposal of improper contents is the right of the retreat staff.

8. Students are not allowed in any dorm room other than the one which they are assigned to without Retreat Staff permission.

9. No PPDA (public or private display of affection).

10. All staff members are authorized to maintain order anywhere on the grounds or while transporting students to or from the Retreat site.

11. Each student will perform his or her duties as part of the privilege of being here. Rooms and adjacent grounds must be kept clean daily, with a final grounds and facilities cleaning and inspection before departure.

12. You are urged and expected to observe habits of personal cleanliness, courtesy, and Christian conduct. Profanity is not allowed.

The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property or an unwholesome attitude on the part of a student will result in expulsion from retreat. Parents are asked to help in explaining these rules to their students and to encourage their compliance. Arrangements and expense of transporting expelled student home is the responsibility of the parents. No refunds will be given to expelled students.
