DROP/WITHDRAW DATE:

- *Anyone unable to complete the training requirements or attend the trip will be responsible for the costs as outlined below.*
- These deadlines are in place as the majority of the trip expenses are non-refundable and prepaid.
- Trip costs such as transportation and lodging are based on the number of participants. **Withdrawals must be received in writing and emailed or mailed to your campus youth pastor to The Assembly at 3500 W New Orleans St. Broken Arrow, OK 74011**

Refund/Withdrawal dates:

Dropping out after April 10th leaves you responsible for 50% of your trip.
Dropping out after May 29th leaves you responsible for 100% of your trip.

Need to know:

- **All AY Missions students are required to be a part of SURGE, which takes place on June 24-26th at both campuses.** As we get closer to SURGE there will be a link to sign up.
- All AY Missions students must attend their campus service June 30th and wear their AY Missions T Shirt.

AY Missions Prep Days:

- **Sundays May 19, June 2,9, & 23 12:30 pm – 4 pm**
 - *Attendance is mandatory to prepare for your trip, learn unique information regarding your trip, and to grow as a team and missions student.*
 - *We understand family vacations and schedules however, due to the limited number of Training Days and the emotional, physical and spiritual preparation required **STUDENTS MUST ATTEND AY MISSIONS Training DAYS!***

AY Fundraisers

Fundraising Opportunities:

- **\$150k days**

- Date: June 6 - 8
- Teams: Teams will be assigned May 1st *(Please begin thinking about jobs for \$150k Days)
- \$150k Days Q&A

- **Q: What is \$150K Days?**

- **A:** \$150K Days is a fundraiser for students grade 6-12 who attend AY and want to raise money for future AY events (it is not limited to mission's trips but can be used for any AY trip). AY trips include, but are not limited to, Spring Retreat, AY Mission Trip, Senior Trip, and Motion Conference and Camp. We spend **50** hours working on jobs that the students and leaders collect in order to reach our shared goal of **\$150K**. At the end of the 50 hours we celebrate with a pizza party. The money each student raises through this fundraiser goes directly into their student account in Managed Missions.

- **Q: Do I have to go on a mission trip in order to work \$150K Days?**

- **A:** No. We encourage every student to be a part of AY Missions, but it is not a requirement to participate in the \$150K Days fundraiser. You can raise money for future youth events as well.

- **Q: Can I have other people work for me/with me to earn more money?**

- **A:** Yes, we allow others to work for/with you in order to raise funds for your student account and future expenses. The amount of people helping assist you cannot exceed 3. Those 3 people, if over the age of 18, must have a background check and have an updated child protection policy. Anyone that you recruit to help you must have permission from your campus youth pastor. Those 3 individuals must be able to work and hold their own on any job that you are doing. Our goal is to help alleviate the financial stresses that each trip costs and our fundraisers are an excellent way to do that.

- **Q: Do teams win something for raising the most money?**

- **A:** Yes! The first and second place teams get a larger percentage of the earnings for their student account.
- **Q: How do I as a student get assigned a team?**
 - **A:** We will open signups Wednesday May 1st after Assembly Youth. We typically have 4 AY teams and 1 Pastor's team. Students can sign up for any team, but we limit the initial signups to 15 students, and parents are allowed to work with their student or on another team if they choose. *If a parent wants to work, simply contact your campus youth pastor by email or calling the church office.*
- **Q: How many hours do we work during \$150K Days?**
 - **A:** The hours of work begin Thursday June 6th @ 1PM and end Saturday June 8th @ 4PM. Any work done outside of this time frame is not considered \$150K Days fundraising and therefore is not included in the money raised for students.
- **Q: What about food breaks and work breaks during \$150K Days?**
 - **A:** Each team is responsible for their own food and break times. The team leaders are fantastic at coordinating this and helping each team to succeed. **If you have questions you need to get with your \$150K Days team leaders.**

- **Student Accounts:**
 - **Q: What are student accounts?**
 - **A:** Student accounts are a personal checking account for your student. Every time a student goes on a trip, money raised or paid is put into their student account. As a student you do not have to "spend it all" each year on trips, during the duration of your time at the Assembly as a student you can save to go on future youth trips while you are an AY Student.
 - **Q: How do I find out about my student account balance?**
 - **A:** If you are going on a trip in the near future (Spring Retreat, AY Missions, etc.) and you would like to check your student account balance you can log on to managedmissions.com to do so. To create a managed missions account you can sign up for Spring Retreat, or you can fill out the online application. Once you have done that you will receive a confirmation email in the next couple of days and you will be able to finish setting up your account.
