DROPPING OUT AFTER MAY 29TH LEAVES YOU RESPONSIBLE FOR 100% OF YOUR TRIP.

FAQ 150K DAYS



WHAT IS \$150K DAYS?

\$150K Days is a fundraiser for AY students in grades 6-12 to earn money for future AY trips and events, such as Spring Retreat, Mission Trips, Motion Conference, and Middle School Camp. Over 50 hours, students and leaders complete jobs they've gathered to help reach a shared goal of \$150,000. At the end of the event, we celebrate with a pizza party! The money each student raises is deposited directly into their Student Account. Sign ups will go live early May.



DO I HAVE TO GO ON A MISSION TRIP IN ORDER TO WORK \$150K DAYS?

No. We encourage every student to be a part of AY Missions, but it is not a requirement to participate in the \$150K Days fundraiser. You can raise money for future youth events like retreats, camps, conferences.



CAN I HAVE OTHER PEOPLE WORK FOR ME/WITH ME TO EARN MORE MONEY?

Yes, we allow others to work for/with you in order to raise funds for your student account and future expenses. The amount of people helping assist you cannot exceed 3. Those 3 people, if over the age of 18, must have a background check and have an updated child protection policy. Anyone that you recruit to help you must have permission from your campus youth pastor. Those 3 individuals must be able to work and hold their own on any job that you are doing. Our goal is to help alleviate the financial stresses that each trip costs and our fundraisers are an excellent way to do that.



DO TEAMS WIN SOMETHING FOR RAISING THE MOST MONEY?

Yes! The first and second place teams get a larger percentage of the earnings for their student account.



HOW DOES A STUDENT GET ASSIGNED A TEAM?

Students can sign up for their preferred team and parents are allowed to work with their student or on another team if they choose. If a parent wants to work, simply contact your campus youth pastor by email or calling the church office. Sign ups will go live early May.





HOW MANY HOURS DO WE WORK DURING \$150K DAYS?

The hours of work begin Thursday June 4th at 1PM and end Saturday, June 6th at 4PM. Any work done outside of this time frame is not considered \$150K Days fundraising and therefore is not included in the money raised for students.



WHAT ABOUT FOOD BREAKS AND WORK BREAKS DURING \$150K DAYS?

Each team is responsible for their own food and break times. The team leaders are fantastic at coordinating this and helping each team to succeed. If you have questions please connect to get with your \$150K Days team leaders.

STUDENT ACCOUNTS



WHAT ARE STUDENT ACCOUNTS?

Student accounts function like a personal savings account for your trips. Any money raised or paid is deposited into your account and can be used for AY trips. You don't have to use all the funds each year—your balance can roll over, allowing you to save for future youth trips as long as you're an AY student at The Assembly.



HOW CAN I CREATE A STUDENT ACCOUNT?

We've updated our system for student accounts.

All student accounts have now been moved to the new platform at **studentaccounts.app**.

To access your account and view your student account balance:

- **Go to studentaccounts.app**
- **Create a new login: Choose whether you're signing in as a student or a parent.**
- **Once logged in, your current balance should appear automatically.**

If your balance doesn't show up right away, please email us right away so we can assist you.

This change will give you easier access to your account information going forward. Let us know if you run into any issues!
