FAQ

Where do I drop off and pick up my student?

Drop off begins at 2:30 PM on Monday at the South Campus Kid's Lobby. Retreat concludes Wednesday night after our 7:00 PM Family Celebration Service. Parents are welcome to join for this service! (ends around 9:30 PM).

Where are students sleeping?

Students will be sleeping at the church in designated, supervised areas separated by grade and gender. Adult leaders are onsite overnight as well as overnight security.

Are boys and girls separated?

Yes. Sleeping and shower areas are fully separated and supervised by same-gender leaders.

How are showers handled?

Students will shower at designated times. We provide shower bags to carry their items. Leaders are present in hallways for supervision and safety.

What about meals?

All meals are provided. If your student has allergies or dietary restrictions, please make sure that information is included in their registration.

How is medication handled?

All medications must be turned in at check-in in their original container with signed Medication Form. The nurse will administer medications. We will have most over the counter medications on hand if your student needs them so please keep those at home.

Are phones allowed?

We have two options for phones. The easiest option is to leave them at home or in the car. If a student does bring a phone, we will collect it at check-in and securely store it. Phones will be checked back out on Wednesday before our Family Celebration Service.

What should my student wear?

Comfortable clothes for services and clothes for rec games. We will be outside and students may get dirty. Please send appropriate-length shorts and modest clothing.

What if my student doesn't know anyone?

We intentionally place students in small groups and teams to help them connect quickly. Leaders are trained to help every student feel included and known.

FAQ

Does my student need extra money?

Extra money is optional. We will have concessions available, our café will be open in the mornings, and retreat merch will be available for purchase. Students may bring spending money if they'd like, but it is not required.

How do you screen your leaders?

All of our leaders are background checked and trained with student safety in mind. We take this very seriously and follow the "Rule of Three," meaning no leader is ever alone or one-on-one with a student. Students are supervised at all times.

How do I reach my student in case of emergency?

At check-in, you will receive the phone number of your student's team leader. You may also contact the church directly during office hours at 918.251.8591.

When will we find out team assignments?

We will announce team colors and assignments during our Combined Service at the Rose Campus on Wednesday, March 10th.

Does my student have to stay on site for the entire retreat?

Yes. In order to safely keep track of every student and build strong community, students are required to stay for the entirety of the retreat.
